The trustees of the Service Fitters Industry Educational Fund are pleased to announce preparatory courses leading to the UA S.T.A.R. HVACR Certification.

Preps and tests start at 8:00 a.m. Deadline to apply is Friday, October 21, 2016.

- **1<sup>st</sup> Prep: Saturday, October 22, 2016**
- **2<sup>nd</sup> Prep: Saturday, October 29, 2016**
- **3<sup>rd</sup> Prep: Saturday, November 5, 2016**  
(Nothing scheduled for 11/12/16 due to holiday weekend)
- **Test Date: Saturday, November 19, 2016**

- Developed jointly by the United Association and Ferris State University, Big Rapids, Michigan
- All service technicians who have at least five years of experience are eligible (must state having at least 5 years of experience on UA Star application).
- Examination consists of 200 questions in the following categories:

Electrical	16	Ventilation	17
Controls	25	Piping	11

- **The cost is \$136 (non-refundable) per examination.** Please make your check or money order payable to NITC, you can also fill out the credit card page of the application to charge this fee to your credit card.
- Applicants who are unsuccessful can re-take the entire examination the next time it is offered (same fee applies).
- Qualified UA members will earn 32 college credits upon passing the examination, credits are applied towards an Associate's Degree in HVACR or Construction Supervision. Washtenaw Community College issues the credits through the UA University. The remaining 30-35 credits needed to complete the degree can be obtained from the UA Regional Training System. - Wallet cards and certificates are provided to service technicians a few weeks after receiving a passing score on the UA Star Mastery Examination.
