Effective July 1, 2025, the Plan will offer a Private School Tuition Benefit for all Participants who have incurred educational expenses for their children or legal dependents who are enrolled in an accredited private school, for kindergarten through twelfth grade.

Covered expenses under this section include, but are not limited to tuition and school supplies, such as laptop computers and other related items, provided they are purchased through the private school and included in the tuition bill.

The Participant must apply for each tuition bill they are requesting reimbursement for and include receipts, invoices, canceled checks and credit card statements, in order for reimbursement to be made. The amount of the benefit requested shall not exceed the Participant's account balance. Applications shall be submitted to the Plan Administrator in the form and manner prescribed by the Trustees.

The Trustees reserve the right to request additional documentation or evidence to determine whether a Participant is entitled to this private school tuition benefit.
